

CAMP JEWELL HEALTH REMINDER

Dear Parent/Guardian of 7th Grade Students;

If your child will be requiring medication to be given while at Camp Jewell, please have your doctor complete this authorization form and return it to me as soon as possible. This includes over the counter medications like Tylenol and Advil, as well as topical preparations. Only FDA approved medications approved for pediatric use may be administered. Vitamins, supplements, and essential oils may not be administered. A separate form is required for each medication.

Please have medication times written for meal times and bedtime (ie: breakfast; lunchtime; dinnertime; and bedtime.)

Students that are required to self-carry medications, such as inhalers and EpiPens, must have their physician write on the form that they are allowed to self-carry.

Medications must be brought to school by parents in a correctly labeled pharmacy bottle as soon as possible.

Medications will not be received the morning we leave for camp.

Students who have medications already ordered and at school do not need new orders, unless there is a change in dosage or frequency. These medications will automatically be sent to camp with your student.

Medications must be picked up by a parent after the trip. Any medications not retrieved by parents will be discarded at the end of the school year.
